

Unknown Suspect Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown hit and run suspect who fatally struck a man in Paradise Hills earlier today.

On January 19, 2017 at about 7:15 a.m., San Diego police officers and fire department personnel responded to a hit and run traffic collision that occurred on the 5900 block of Albemarle Street in the Paradise Hills neighborhood of San Diego. The victim was a 49-year-old man who was retrieving an umbrella from his parked car. A vehicle, traveling on the opposite side of the road, crossed the double yellow lines and struck the victim while he was near his parked car. The victim was thrown a short distance onto the side of the road. Neighbors heard the collision and tried to help the injured man by providing CPR and calling 911. The male victim was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the vehicle did not stop and fled the area.

San Diego police detectives recovered several videos from the area and determined that a silver vehicle was involved in the hit and run.

Suspect Vehicle Description: *It is described as a silver 4-door Lexus ES 330 2004-2006 with left front and driver side damage. The windshield may be cracked on the driver side also.*
