## **Suspects Wanted for Burglary**

## Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

May 7, 2019

San Diego County Crime Stoppers along with investigators from the Chula Vista Police Department are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the suspects involved in a construction trailer burglary.

On April 17, 2019, at approximately 2:21 a.m., two unknown male suspects forced entry into a construction trailer that was located at 600 East Palomar Street, in Chula Vista. The suspects stole approximately \$18,000 worth of tools including a generator, ground compactor, and a hydrostatic pump.

Investigators believe the suspects were driving a stolen 2000 maroon colored Chevrolet full-size pickup truck with a California license plate of 7D70263. The vehicle has an aftermarket grille guard and push bumper installed on its front bumper.

## Suspect's Description:

Suspect # 1 is described as a Hispanic male, 20 to 30-years-old, thin build, short dark hair, earring in right ear, and unknown tattoos on both biceps.

Suspect # 2 is described as a Hispanic male, 20 to 30-years-old, heavyset, short dark hair, thick rimmed glasses, mustache, goatee, wearing a thick gold chain over his t-shirt.
