San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the FBI are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown suspect wanted in connection with a bank robbery in San Diego.

On June 5, 2017, at approximately 11:00 am, a male suspect walked into the Union Bank, located at 6010 El Cajon Blvd in San Diego and presented a demand note to a bank teller. The demand note indicated that he had a gun. The teller complied with the suspect's demands and gave him an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect fled the bank on foot.

Suspect's Description:

The robber is described as an African-American male, with braided hair, standing approximately 6'00", with a stocky build. The robber was last seen wearing a tan jacket, with a plaid shirt, and unknown type of pants.
