

Unknown Suspect Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown suspect who struck a bicyclist with a vehicle in the Linda Vista area.

On November 25, 2016, at 2:49 p.m., an adult male was riding a bicycle eastbound on 6900 Morley Way, in the Linda Vista area of San Diego. The bicyclist failed to stop at a stop sign located at Morley Way and Morley Street and rode directly into the path of a vehicle that was traveling southbound on 2300 Morley Street. The vehicle did not stop after the collision and continued southbound on Morley Street and was last seen driving southbound on Linda Vista Road. The victim sustained facial lacerations and fractures to his right leg.

Suspect's Description:

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male in his 20's with short black hair. The suspect's vehicle is described as a light metallic colored Toyota Corolla, possibly a 1998-2000 year model, with hood, windshield, and passenger side front headlight damage.
