Unsolved Homicide of Lori Ann Mooney

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

December 26, 2018

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying the suspect(s) who murdered Lori Ann Mooney 27 years ago.

On June 8, 1991, at approximately 6:09 a.m., San Diego Police Officers responded to the Clairemont Friendship Senior Center (located within the North Clairemont Park and Recreation Center) for a report of a deceased body found. A nearby resident discovered the body of 29-year-old Lori Ann Mooney during his morning walk. Homicide investigators determined that Mooney had been shot several hours earlier and died as a result of those injuries.

Mooney was a resident of Clairemont and up until the time of her death, had frequented the area near the Friendship Senior Center. Mooney was often seen riding around the neighborhood on her Suzuki motorcycle.
