# Suspect Wanted for Felony Battery

## Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

October 21, 2022

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Eastern Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the suspect responsible for a felony battery that occurred in the College area of San Diego.

*On October 1, 2022, at about 11:45 p.m., an 18-year-old male victim was standing in the parking lot of the Senor Pancho restaurant located at 5089 College Avenue, in San Diego. As the victim had his back turned, an unknown suspect walked up from behind him and punched him once in his face with a closed fist. The victim fell to the ground and was rendered unconscious. The suspect got into a white Dodge Charger and fled the area.*

*The victim was transported to a local hospital for medical treatment. The victim sustained a broken jaw and other injuries to his head and hip.*

**Suspect's Description:**

The suspect is described as a Black male, 5'10" to 6'1" tall, weighs 200 to 220 lbs., with short dreadlocks hair style, wearing a white hooded sweatshirt and black pants. The suspect was driving away in a 2018 or newer white Dodge Charger, with dark window tint and no front license plate.
